WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 17 - 23 July, 2006

INTERFACE FIRE

On 21 Jul 06, a forest fire threatened the Anahim FN Reserve near Alexis Creek and a tactical evacuation of 28 homes involving 50 to 60 residents was conducted. Evacuees were relocated with friends and relatives and due to the situation improving significantly overnight evacuees were allowed to return to their homes at 20:00 on 22 Jul 06. No homes were reported as damaged and no one was injured in this incident. The NEA PREOC was activated to level 1 in support of the situation and effective 12:00 on 23 Jul 06 they stood down.

On 23 Jul 06, a forest fire started on the south end of Galiano Island and due to fire behaviour and high winds the situation deteriorated forcing the evacuation of 119 residents. The Capital Regional District (CRD) issued a Declaration of State of Local Emergency effective 00:30 on 24 Jul 06 for all of Galiano Island. The CRD activated an Emergency Operations Center (EOC) on Pender Island and CRD Emergency Social Services program activated a reception centre at Lions Hall on Galiano Island to receive evacuees. Volunteer Search and Rescue Teams were transported by Canadian Coast Guard to the island to assist with evacuations. The Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre (PREOC) in Victoria and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) in Victoria activated at a level 2 (24/7) to provide support to local government and continue to work with the CRD, RCMP, Ministry of Forests (MOF), Office of the Fire Commissioner (OFC) and other stakeholders to ensure that resource needs are met and information is provided in a timely manner.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 17 July 06, Prince George SAR responded to assist RCMP with an evidence search.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 17 July 06 a reception centre was set up for a few hours to receive residents from 40 to 50 units from an apartment building on Craigflower Road in Esquimalt. Residents were displaced due to noxious odors from pepper spray in a liquid form.

On 20 July 06 Fort George Hwy Rescue members were requested by BCAS to assist by meeting a vehicle at intersection of Camp Road and Hwy 97 with patient suffering from chest pains.

On 20 July 06, Logan Lake Fire Dept responded to assist BCAS with a quad that had rolled over.

On 20 July 06, an apartment complex, fire in Coquitlam resulted in approximately 300 residents from 3 buildings being evacuated. 59 registered with ESS and another 135 were supplied with food and lodging and some were allowed to return to their apartments in the other buildings. Coquitlam EOC was activated to level 1 to assist with situation and the SWE PREOC stood by to assist as needed.

On 23 July 06 – Ridge Meadow SAR was tasked to transport 3 forestry firefighters up Pitt Lake to the Osprey Creek Fire as they could not get in by heli due to nightfall.
