WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 07 Aug to 13 Aug 2006

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 07 Aug 06, a house fire became a concern when it threatened to impact a1000 gallon propane tank situated near the burning structure, 56 km north of Fort St. John. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by Ministry of Environment (MOE) Response Officer (RO) due to the potential threat of an explosion. The fire department did not respond as it was outside the fire protection area. Milligan Creek Road, a main transportation link to oil fields in the area, was closed by RCMP. The house burned to the ground without further incident and the road was re-opened.

On 08 Aug 06, a CN rail car carrying rock sulphur derailed and became engulfed in flames at Mile 94 near Irvin just outside of Vavenby. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential threat to public safety and the environment. The local Fire Departments were dispatched and the Ministry of Forests (MoF) Protection Branch conducted an aerial reconnaissance of the site. Notifications were made to Environment Canada (EC), Ministry of Health, and the Thompson Nicola Regional District (TNRD) Emergency Program Coordinator (EPC). The incident was downgraded after the fire was contained and suppressed.

On 09 Aug 06, a discharge of Sulphur Dioxide was released from the Marsulex chemical plant on Pacific Street in Prince George. A plume contaminated an area downwind of the plant and 9 workers from the Rustad Mill, a division of Canfor, suffered exposure and were transported to hospital for treatment. The release was a one time discharge and the plume dissipated. The Northern Health Authority, Prince George Emergency Program Coordinator, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Environment, PEP Regional Manager in Prince George and Environment Canada were advised and monitored the situation.
