**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 30 OCT-05 NOV 2006**

**STORM EVENT**

An intense Pacific frontal system arrived late evening Sunday, 05 November. Rain began to fall throughout the South Coast at 1800h, with heavy rain beginning about 2200h, and was expected to continue throughout the following day. Very high rain magnitudes and intensities were measured at some stations. A Flood Warning was issued by the Ministry of Environment River Forecast Centre. Areas of concern were as follows: South Vancouver Island, Greater Vancouver, North Shore Mountains and Lower Fraser Valley as far east as Hope. The Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centres (PREOCs) in Victoria and Surrey were activated as well as the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) to provide support, technical advice and expertise to local governments in the affected areas. **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 01 Nov 06, Vernon SAR responded to a request from the Animal Welfare Society to rescue a dog stranded on a rock face for three days. The dog was successfully rescued and turned over to the SPCA.

On 02 Nov 06, assistance was provided to a single father and three children who were displaced from their residence in Nanaimo and required accommodation.
