EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 17 Nov 06, Juan de Fuca, Victoria, Saanich and PEMO SAR responded to RCMP request to conduct an evidence search near Port Renfrew.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 17 Nov 06, due to a motor vehicle incident that severed fiber optic cabling, 911 service was disrupted for several communities from Houston west along the corridor to the Queen Charlotte Islands. PEP Amateur Radio and BC Emergency net was activated to provide a public safety communications back up until TELUS was able to repair the damage and restore service to the affected communities.

TSUNAMI

On November 15 at 0314 PST an earthquake magnitude 8.1 occurred in the Kuril Islands (46.7 N 153.5 E). The West Coast and Alaska Tsunami Warning Centre (WC ATWC) issued a Tsunami Warning for Coastal Alaska, and a Tsunami Watch for Coastal British Columbia. The Provincial Emergency Notification System was launched by PEP and B.C. coastal communities, key agencies and the media were alerted. The tsunami warning and watch were cancelled by WC ATWC on November 15 at 0641 PST.
