**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 23 Nov 06, municipal staff responded to flood damages on the municipal water system in Chemainus. Staff worked to clear gravel and debris, flushed the system and notified residents not to use the water. A Boil Water Advisory was put into effect.

On 26 Nov 06, residents at a seniors home on Gabriola Island required ESS assistance due to a power outage in the area.

On 26 Nov 06, a severe winter storm resulted in significant snowfall on Southern Vancouver Island which caused power outages in a number of communities. Langford Emergency Social Services placed personnel on standby in the event that conditions worsened overnight and a reception centre was required.
