### WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Dec 11 - 17 2006

#### SEVERE STORM

On December 15, 2006 the third of three storms hit BC coastal areas over night resulting in widespread damage from fallen trees, downed power lines and phone outages. A number of communities on Vancouver Island and the lower mainland experienced extended power outages due to wind storms which occurred the previous weekend. The south island was hit hardest by the storm with wind gusts in excess of 170 km/hr being recorded in Juan de Fuca Strait. Provincial Regional Emergency Operation Centres (PREOCs) in Surrey and Victoria and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) in Victoria continue to be activated in support of local government response.
