SAR members managed to drive in and using their Zodiac brought them off the island and transported them into town.

One injured person was rescued prior to Search and Rescue being called in. Two RCMP helicopters were used to conduct grid searches. The search was scaled back and SAR members stood down after a thorough search had been conducted and no other people were located needing help.

WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT DEC 18 – 24 2006

SEVERE WEATHER

Extended power outages continued due to windstorm damage throughout Vancouver Island and Lower Mainland regions. Provincial Regional Emergency Operation Centres (PREOCs) in Surrey and Victoria and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) in Victoria were activated in support of local government response.

On 18 Dec 06, a task number was issued to the Kitimat/Stikine Regional District due to heavy rainfall causing flooding in several low lying areas. The Regional District activated their Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to a level 1 to monitor the situation. The source of flooding was identified as the emergency protective work being done in the area and the Regional District provided pumps. Overnight the rains eased and with that the water drainage issues improved substantially. A number of damages were reported.

On 18 Dec 06, a task number was issued to the City of Terrace due to snow and heavy rainfall resulting in numerous reports of flooding throughout the area, the City of Terrace activated their EOC to a level 1 to monitor the situation. The excessive water caused erosion to an area outside of Terrace exposing a primary PNG pipeline (Pacific Northern Gas Ltd.). PNG shut down the pipeline to prevent any spills or environmental impact and a secondary gas line going into Terrace was utilized to minimize impact to the community. The rains eased substantially overnight and the water drainage issues improved considerably. A number of damages were reported.
