Principles followed for prioritizing user maintained recreation sites and trails for funding:

- Weather restrictions and limitations to complete work
- Fair and equitable distribution of funds across the province
- Fair and equitable distribution of funds for all types of trail activities

Upgrading recreation sites and trails may include repair / replacement of structures (tables, toilets, fire pits, signs), tree hazard assessment and abatement, toilet pumping, gravelling and grading of roads within the recreation site or trail parking area.

The following sites/trails have been identified for improvements based on a general assessment of safety/environmental risks and recognition/support from the local community. This list may be amended as factors such as weather, road access and opportunities to leverage more resources influence the priorities at the time improvements are ready to be undertaken.
