Timothy Establishment Underseeded to Wheat Creston Summer 1994

### Introduction

The planning process provides producers with the opportunity to look at their operation as a group of distinct enterprises. Alternative enterprises should be evaluated on the basis of **Contribution Margin**, taking into consideration resource constraints, market opportunity, risk and uncertainty.

The Contribution Margin must provide funds for interest, overhead and other indirect expenses as well as a return for living expenses, loan repayment and investment. These items should be included in the overall farm plan which will include a Projected Income Statement and Projected Cash Flow Budget.

### **Key Factors Affecting Profit**

	Target
Wheat Yield	1.4 MT/acre (50 bu/acre)
Wheat Price	\$150-160/MT (\$4.30/bu)

Yields are affected by proper and timely fertilizer application. Wheat is grown to provide income during the establishment year and to help control weeds. Timothy does not yield a seed crop in the first year.

### **Marketing Alternatives**

Timothy for seed is grown primarily for the Japanese market and is contracted through U.S. seed dealers. Contracts are normally for four years. Contracts guarantee acceptance of production only, not price. Prices are set at the time of delivery. Creston's Hard Red Spring Wheat is generally marketed in the U.S. Premiums are available for high protein wheat.

### **Rules of Thumb**

Machinery Investment <\$1,100/acre
Direct Expenses % of Income 50 - 60%

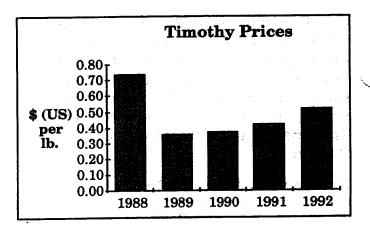
