Whether the cost is internalized or visible, only purchasers of those products will pay a fee.

It's surprising that a group that claims to represent taxpayers would argue against efforts to relieve taxpayers of some of the financial burden of operating landfills.

The eco-fees in B.C. will likely be similar to fees that have been in place in Alberta for more than a year. There have been very few complaints about the fees by consumers in that province.

Our government will bring in a regulation that works for producers, consumers and those responsible for recycling. Pretending that electronic waste isn't a problem is not a responsible option.
