

## **CERTIFICATION OF SPECIES IDENTIFICATION**

The purpose of this form is to identify the wildlife specimen, for which a permit is being applied for. At this time, only Registered Professional Biologists, a Provincial Government Employee of the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection (i.e. Biologist or Conservation Officer) or a person deemed acceptable to the Ministry, may identify the wildlife specimen.

\*see reverse side for those species for which a permit will **NOT** be issued or **MAY** be issued. The applicant should include this completed form, the Permit Application and the fee and submit to the Permit and Authorization Bureau. To be completed by the person who wishes to obtain a Permit for the wildlife specimen for the purposes of taxidermy. (full mailing address and phone number) understand that I am NOT in legal possession of the wildlife specimen until I obtain a Permit from the B.C. Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection. 1. Permits will **NOT** be issued for those species covered under the Migratory Birds Convention Act. The following species are covered under the Migratory Birds Convention Act:

Waterfowl; cranes; rails and coots; shorebirds, including gulls and terns; pigeons and doves; insectivorous songbirds (excluding blackbirds); seabirds; loons; grebes; herons, egrets and bitterns.

2. Permits will **NOT** be issued for:

Bald Eagles and Golden Eagles
White Pelicans
Spotted Owls
Ferruginous Hawks
Peregrine Falcons
Burrowing Owls
Prairie Falcons
Pelagic Cormorants

Brandt's Cormorants Northern Goshawk (Queen Charlottes only)

3. The Regional Manager must be contacted to determine if a permit **MAY** be issued for:

Snowy Owls
Great Grey Owls
Gyrfalcons
Black Bear - hides

Grizzly Bear - hides and skulls

Sheep, goat and Bison - horns

All Ungulates – hides and capes
