BC Ministry of Education CURRICULUM REVISION & IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE K-12

This document provides a brief overview of the ongoing work of the Ministry of Education to ensure that the K-12 provincial curriculum continues to be both current and relevant. These revision and implementation timelines take into consideration the consultation process during the revision stages of curriculum documents, the cycle of learning resource development and evaluation, and the translation into French of curriculum documents and related resources.

All provincial curricula are described in a separate line in the following table. The latest revision date is shown underneath each curriculum,

- 4. **Grades K-7 implementation:** many of the revised curricula now have a 3-year implementation window (first 2 years optional; 3rd year mandatory) in order to provide school districts with flexibility with regard to their own overall curriculum implementation planning.
- 5. **Grades 10-12 implementation:** there is no optional implementation year for Grade 10 to 12 curricula for which there is a provincial examination.
- 6. Curriculum revision process:
 - Curriculum in BC is revised every 8 years.
 - All curriculum revision processes begin with a research and survey phase that determines the extent and direction of change needed.
 - Teams of experts and specialist teachers then proceed to the curriculum writing phase and produce a draft revised curriculum that is posted on the ministry website for response, and may be piloted by the Ministry.
 - During the same time period, a call for learning resources is sent to publishers. Following a rigorous evaluation process, recommended resources are added to the Grade Collection.
 - The final revised curriculum is then published and made available for planning and implementation (http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/irp/irp.htm).
