THIS COURT ORDERS:


1. no person shall publish in any document, or broadcast or publicly transmit in any way any information that could identify the undercover operators in the investigation of the Accused;



4. any interested person may apply to set aside any order granted herein on three (3) clear days notice to Counsel for the RCMP Undercover Police Officers.
