Thank you for the invitation to be here today. Regrettably, Premier Gordon Campbell was unable to attend – and I bring greetings on his behalf and that of the Province.

I am delighted to be here this afternoon joining a group of people who have accomplished something extraordinary. You've worked to provide your community with something that will benefit generations of Delta residents and the celebration today is the culmination of the tremendous effort undertaken to manage this major capital project.

The expansion to emergency room services is very important in this part of the province. We all know how critical emergency care is – especially when it comes to our families, our friends and our community. Increasing capacity means better access to emergency care for Delta residents.

At a cost of \$6 million it will nearly triple ER capacity at Delta Hospital. This will benefit the more than 23,000 patients who come into this ER every year.
