- File a separate Notice of Revocation for each waiver to be revoked and a copy of the relevant waiver with the commissioner.
- This Notice will revoke the attached Waiver six months after the date this Notice is filed. If you send the Notice by mail, it is considered to have been filed on the day that the envelope containing the Notice is postmarked.
- You cannot rescind or cancel a Notice of Revocation after it has been filed.

- This Notice of Revocation must be signed by the operator, taxpayer, legal representative of the taxpayer or, if a corporation, an authorized signing officer.
