



Licence to Harvest Marine Plants

Due application for this licence having been made, accompanied by the payment of the licence fee of \$110.00 the licensee hereinafter named is hereby licensed, pursuant to Section 24 of the *Fisheries Act* (R.S.B.C.) and the regulations thereunder, to harvest marine plants from the area(s) herein referred to. This licence is subject to suspension or revocation in the event (a) the licensee has failed to comply with a condition of a licence, or (b) the harvesting of kelp or other aquatic plants under the licence would (i) tend to impair or destroy a bed or part of a bed on which kelp or other aquatic plants grow, (ii) tend to impair or destroy the supply of any food for fish, or (iii) be detrimental to fish life.

Harvest method Hand harvesting only, using a sharp cutting instrument.

Manner of harvest Only individual fronds are to be cut. No more than 25% of the fronds on any individual plant are to be cut.

This licence becomes effective on the 28th day of February 2001 and

expires on the 30th day of June 2001
