

Major Regulation Changes for 2006-2007

- I. New motor vehicle restriction above 1450 m in MUs 7-38, 7-39 and 7-40.
- 2. Motor vehicle restrictions lifted for Finlay Russell Forest Rd and Selkutz Forest Rd below 1450 m.
- 3. Restrictions on the use of snowmobiles for hunting shortened by 2 weeks for all of Omineca Region.
- 4. Omineca Mining Road Extension (MUs 6-18, 7-39) No Shooting Area removed.
- 5. New youth seasons for white-tailed and mule deer.
- 6. Expanded white-tailed deer, mule deer and elk seasons.
- 7. Compulsory reporting for moose no longer required.

REGIONAL BAG LIMITS

- ▶ Deer: The bag limit for mule (black-tailed) deer in Region 7A and 7B (Omineca/Peace) is three. Only one buck may be taken in region 7A and 7B combined. The bag limit for mule deer bucks in 7B is one in two years, therefore a hunter who takes a mule deer buck in 7B cannot take another in 7B until the calendar year of the kill and subsequent calendar year have expired. One mule deer may be antlerless available only under a Limited Entry Hunting authorization. The bag limit for white-tailed deer is one
- ▶ **Grouse**:The regional daily aggregate bag limit for grouse is 10 (blue spruce (Franklin), ruffed). The regional daily bag limit for ptarmigan is 10.
- ▶ Thinhorn Mountain Sheep: The regional bag limit is one sheep in three years. A hunter who harvests a thinhorn sheep cannot hunt or kill another thinhorn sheep until the calendar year of the kill and two subsequent calendar years have expired. Hunters who harvested an under 8 year sheep under the previous bag limit will have that bag limit carried forward such that they cannot hunt or kill another thinhorn sheep until the calendar year of the kill and 2 subsequent years have expired. ACCESS MANAGEMENT AREAS

- ▶ There are a number of restrictions and prohibitions in this Region. See definitions of "motor vehicle", "ATV" and "snowmobile" in Definitions section.
- ▶ Information signs may be posted at the points of closure for road and vehicle restrictions. These signs are for the benefit of hunters, but it is the hunters' responsibility to recognize closures whether a sign is in place or not.
- Symbol Key: Use the following symbols to determine what type of motor vehicle prohibition is in place in the following regional MUs (see also Site and Access Restrictions section, pages 11-12 and regional maps):

★ Motor Vehicle Closed Areas

The operation of all motor vehicles is prohibited in these areas.

▲ Motor Vehicles for Hunting Closed Areas

The operation of all motor vehicles for the purpose of hunting to transport wildlife, to transport equipment, fireams and supplies which are intended for or in support of hunting or to transport hunters to and from the location of wildlife is prohibited in these areas.

♦ ATVs for Hunting Closed Areas

The operation of ATVs (including motorcycles) for the purpose of hunting, to transport wildlife, to transport fireams or equipment and supplies which are intended for or in support of hunting, or to transport hunters to or from the location of wildlife is prohibited in these areas.

▼ Snowmobiles for Hunting Closed Areas The operation of snowmobiles for the purpose of hunting, to transport wildlife, to transport firearms or equipment and supplies which are

- intended for or in support of hunting or to transport hunters to and from the location of wildlife is prohibited in these areas.
- Snowmobile Closed Areas: The operation of snowmobiles is prohibited in these areas, except snowmobiles used for commercial puposes (includingtrapping).

- Howard (MU 7-2) as shown on Map G4. This area in the headwaters of Howard Creek drainage proceeds north up-slope from Howard Creek to the ridge top, then west to the height of land and southeast along this height of land, then back to Howard Creek.
- * Foster Creek (MU 7-2) as shown on Map G4.

 Creek and east of the height of land is from
 1300 m elevation up to the treeless alpine
 (which is open to snowmobiles), with an open
 access route on Foster Road (snowmobiles
 permitted Dec 1 to May 31).
- * Canoe River-North Thompson (MUs 3-44, 7-2) as shown on Map G3, west of Highway 5 between Canoe River and the North Thompson River. The westerly boundary generally follows heights of land and alpine/forest edges in the Canoe, Camp, Allan and North Thompson watersheds. Seasonally open snowmobiling areas include the Allan and Oasis areas, which are marked with trail head signs.
- Encampment Creek (MU 7-2) as shown on attached Map G4. The area above I 300 m elevation which is between Foster Creek south arm and the height of land separating Foster and Encampment Creek drainages.

NOTICE TO HUNTERS

▶ Hunters, while returning from hunting, are required to keep the antlers of a bull moose taken in the Omineca sub-region, and the species licence under which the moose was taken together and available for inspection by an officer of MoE.

▶ A few white moose have been noticed in MU 7-13. Hunters are requested not to shoot a white moose due to their uniqueness and viewing value to all people who enjoy wildlife.

PROVINCIAL PARKS, RECREATION AREAS AND PROTECTED AREAS

- ▶ Please refer to Site and Access Restrictions section for more information.
- ▶ All Provincial Parks, Protected Areas and Ecological Reserves are closed to ATV use unless authorized under park use permit.






Map G10 Purden Lake Park addition (situated in MU 7-7).


Map GII Tabor Mountain No




Map G12 Red Rock Seed Orchard No Shooting Area (situated in MU 7-10).




Map G17 Miworth No Shooting Area (situated in MU 7-15).




Map G18 Gleason Creek Mountain Goat Closed Area (situated in MU 7-18).




Map G19 Monkman Lake Park area open to hunting (situated in MU 7-18).
