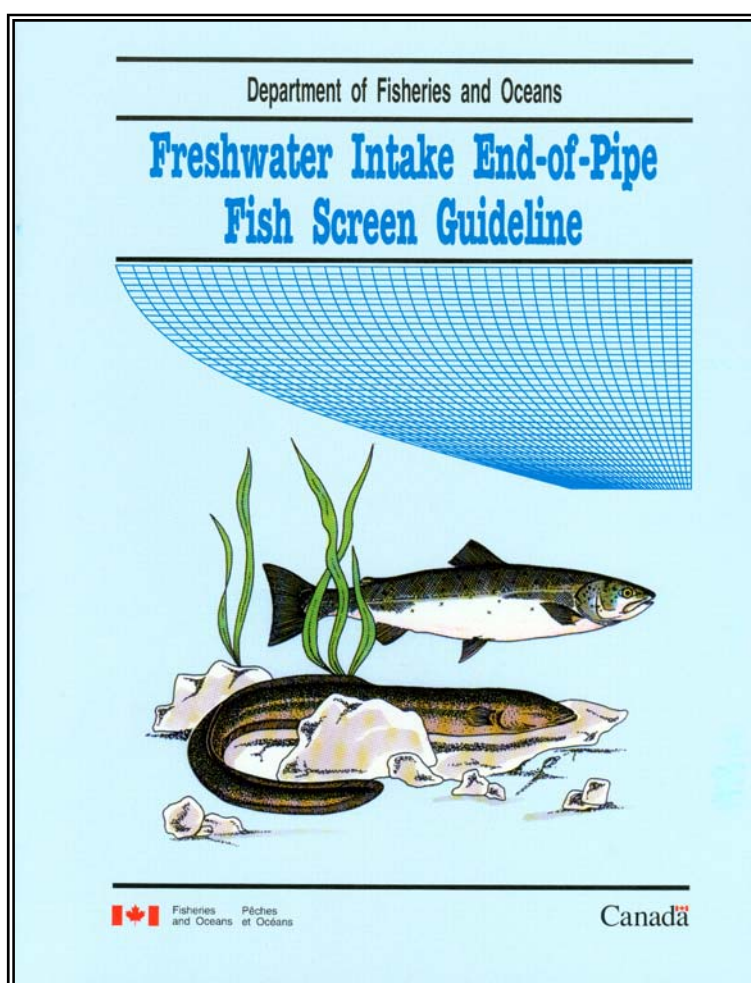




FRESHWATER INTAKE END-OF-PIPE FISH SCREEN GUIDELINE
