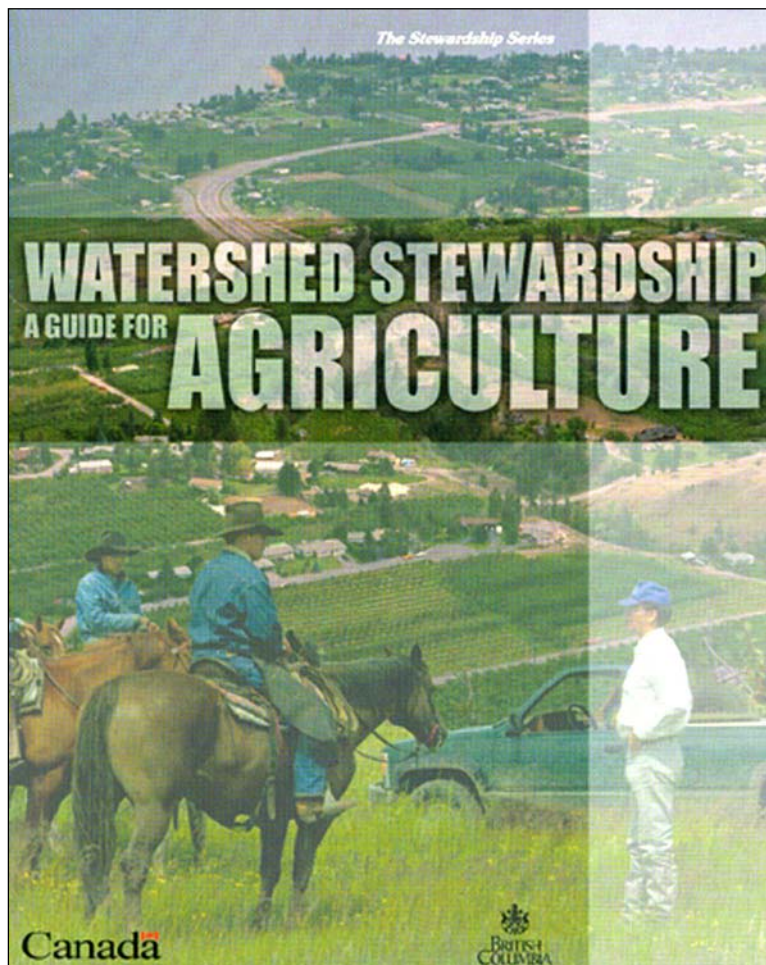




WATERSHED STEWARDSHIP A Guide for Agriculture
