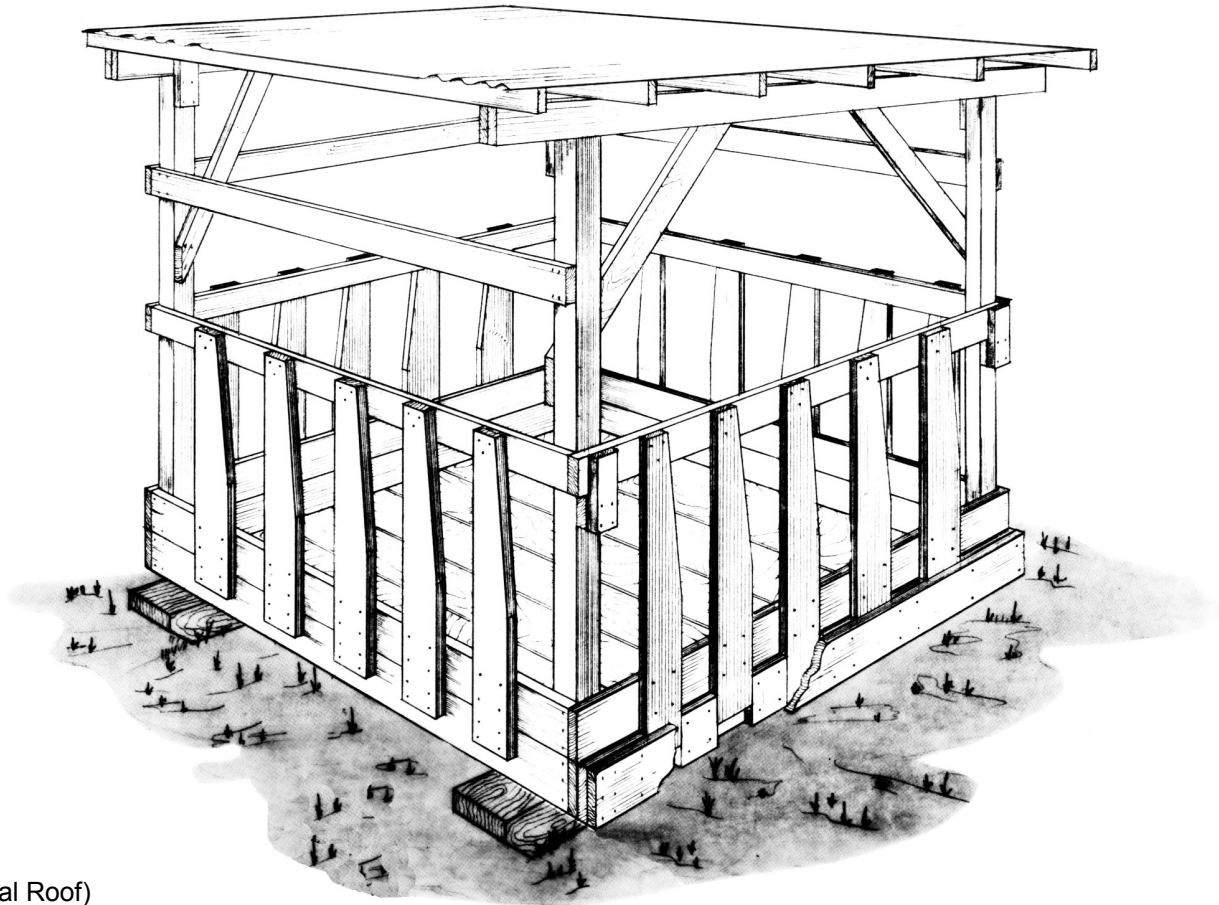


TOMBSTONE FEEDER FOR ROUND BALES - WITH ROOF



(Optional Roof)

This leaflet gives details for making a simple feed fence enclosure for self-feeding round bales to cattle.

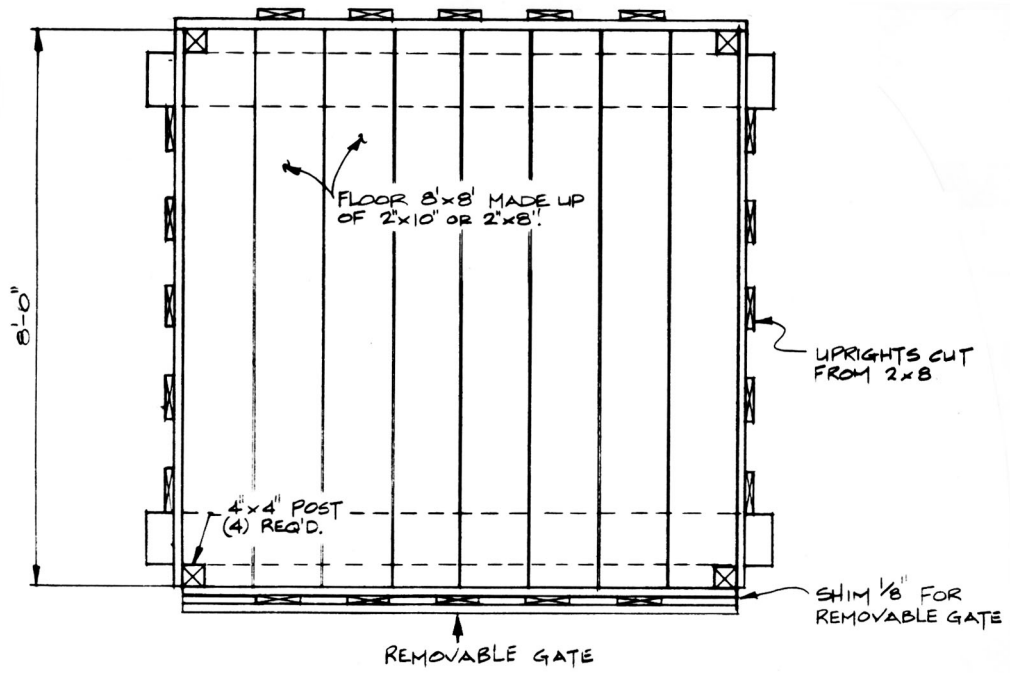
This feeder is an adaptation of the tombstone feed fence principle, a proven feed saver for both dairy and beef cattle feeding.

Cattle are hard on feeding equipment. The tapered vertical dividers, in particular, should be reasonably free of knots, splits, and other large defects.

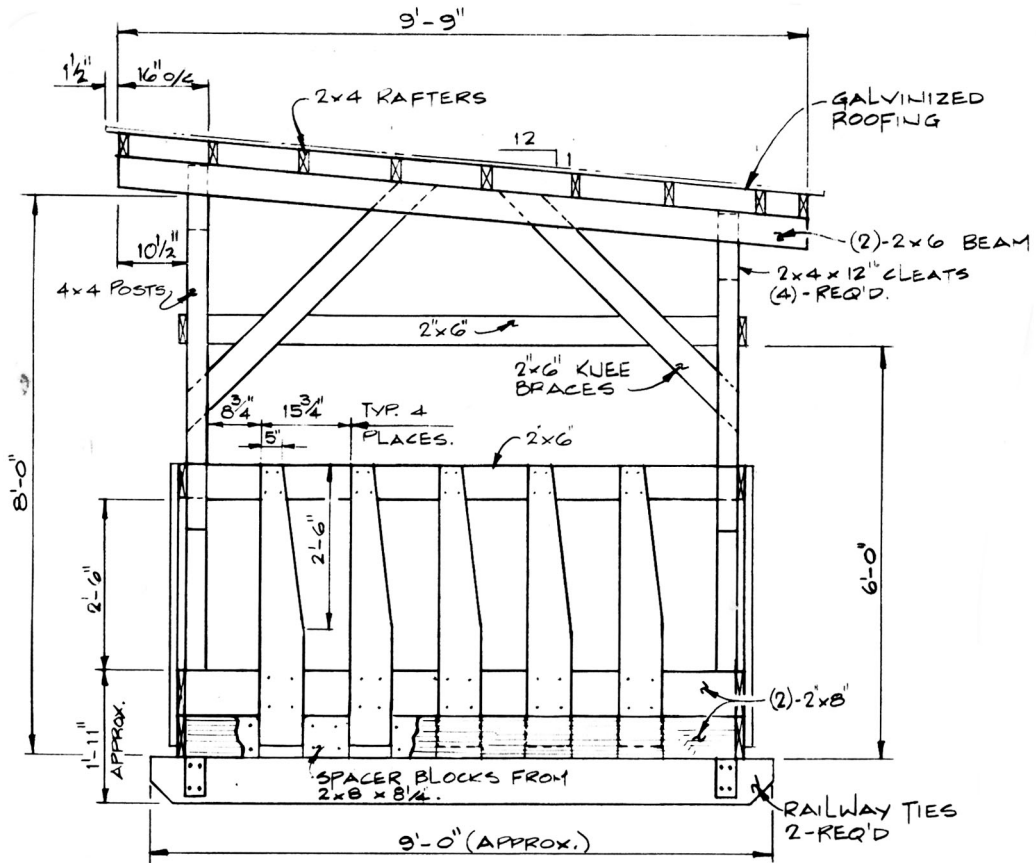
Connections must be strongly made with clinched nails or bolts. The raised floor helps keep hay off the wet ground for feedlots in high-rainfall areas.

This leaflet is similar to CPS 1643 with the following exceptions:

- Roof to reduce spoilage and keep out precipitation
- Removable panel for loading in bales through one side.
- Top edge of tombstone is supported by 2" x 6" rail for added strength
