


PORTABLE CALF CREEP GRAIN FEEDER

Creep feeding of calves on the range is practiced by many cattlemen as a means of increasing weaning weight and supplementing existing pasture.

This plan provides construction details of a small self-feeder equipped for use as a calf-creep feeder. The feeder is built on skids for portability and low to the ground so that only calves can use it. It accommodates

twelve calves at one time. The feeder section is V-bottomed for self-feeding, and holds about 90 cubic feet of feed. Roofing and sheathing are made of plywood and the frame is made of 2 x 4 and 2 x 6 in. lumber.

This feeder should be located on high ground to assure good drainage and in a place convenient for filling.
