


WORKING CORRAL WITH COVERED AREA



BEEF CATTLE WORKING CORRAL C/W COVERED AREA

This plan for a working corral provides for all the essential handling operations normally required on a ranch or feedlot.

A crowding pen with crowding gate herds animals into the chute with minimum effort. The blocking gate provides for one-way access to the working chute. The working chute is 36 feet long, although this length can be altered. A catwalk along this chute is essential for easy moving of cattle. The working chute includes two blocking gates. Using a cutting gate the working chute splits off to either a curved chute leading to the squeeze, or to the loading ramp.

The working area surrounding the squeeze is covered. Isolation pens are provided in the covered area, as well as an office.
