


FIXED MINERAL BOX

FIXED MINERAL BOX

The mineral box is a practical method of providing minerals to sheep in field or feedlot.

This box is framed and sheathed on the back, sides and bottom with plywood. A front board prevents wastage. Vertical spacers provide individual feed openings. Flat iron hangers are fastened to the back of the box for hanging on a fence or a building, and a steel pipe guard rail around the front keeps the sheep from soiling the inside of the box.

- 1. 3/8" plywood
- 2. 2" x 2" framing
- 3. 1" x 4" front board
- 4. 45° cant strip, out of 2" x 2"
- 5. 2" x 2" leg
- 6. 1" x 3" dividers
- 7. 3/4" diam. pipe, ends flattened and drilled for 5/16" bolts
- 8. hooks, out of flat iron
