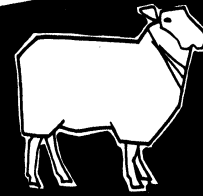

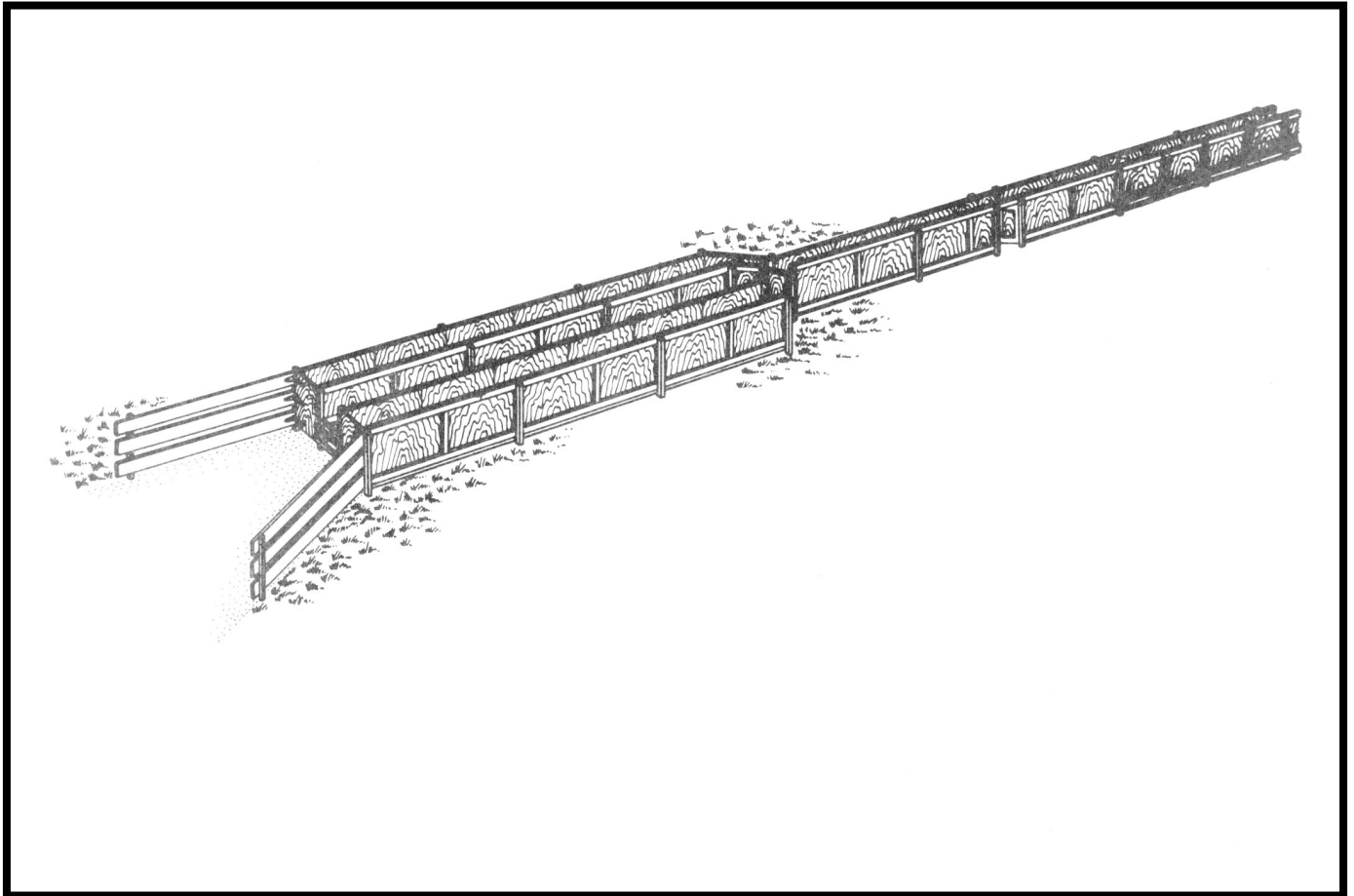

SPRAYING-SORTING CHUTE AND ACCESSORIES

This is detailed plan for construction of a spraying chute with an overhead walk for the operator. Details for a foot bath and an adapter to narrow the sorting chute for lambs are also shown.

Construction Features

This is a twin chute set-up with a raised wooden walk for the operator to stand between the two chutes of sheep to be treated. The advantage of the two chutes is that one chute can be filling with sheep while the sheep in the other chute are being treated.

A continuous flow of animals can thus be provided for treatment.

The foot bath is built with pressure treated lumber and is located in the outlet part of the chute. The wooden chute adapter can be hung on the inside of the chute to reduce the inside width of the chute to 12 in. to accommodate lambs.

Details are shown for the working chute and the cutting gates.
