

PRE-BUDGET CONSULTATION IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The all-party Select Standing Committee on Finance and Government Services of the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia has been authorized to examine the pre-budget consultation paper prepared by the Minister of Finance and Corporate Relations and, in particular, to conduct public consultations across British Columbia regarding provincial budgetary and financial policy for the coming year.

The committee is eager to hear your views on the challenges facing British Columbia, and alternative measures the government may consider to address those challenges as it prepares its 2001-2002 budget.
