BARK BEETLE - RED CEDAR

(Phloeosinus sequoiae)

Grubs feed by burrowing through the bark of weakened plants, causing twigs and branches to die. Larvae pupate in the tunnels and adults emerge to lay eggs in other trees. Susceptible plants are usually stressed from drought, mechanical injury, compaction, or root rots.
