SOWBUGS

Description

Sowbugs, also called woodlice and pillbugs, have dark, segmented, flattened, oval-shaped bodies with 7 pairs of legs. At night they emerge form their damp, dark hiding places and move about rapidly, feeding on decaying plant matter, and occasionally on roots and stems of living plants. Damage is seen as irregularly shaped holes on the leaves of host plants. Seedlings are particularly susceptible.
