

Pelargonium (geranium)

Oedema

Yellow or tan-coloured areas with small water-soaked blisters appear on undersides of leaves, and occasionally on stems and petioles. These spots turn corky and brown resulting in yellowing and dropping of leaves. Occurs during cool, cloudy weather and whenever susceptible varieties are overwatered. It occurs mostly on ivy geraniums.
