- Your receipts will be returned to you.
- Incomplete forms will be returned to you.



# INSTRUCTION PAGE

#### FOR COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION FOR REFUND OF PROVINCIAL FUEL TAX FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES FORM (FIN 472)



Fuel receipts must be submitted with your refund claim, as the receipts provide proof of the amount of tax paid. Each fuel receipt must show that fuel was purchased, the date the fuel was purchased, the number of litres purchased, and the seller's name and address.

This program was changed to run on a calendar year basis (i.e. January 1 to December 31). However, in order to make this change, the branch established an interim period during 2002. This interim refund period runs from August 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002. This 5-month period has a refund maximum of \$170.00.

(\$400 annual maximum  $\div$  12 months = \$33.33 per month x 5 months = \$166.67 rounded to \$170)

To calculate the litres for the new calendar year refund period January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003:

- i) Put all your receipts that fall between January 1, 2003 and December 31, 2003 in date order.
- ii) Add the litres from these receipts to obtain the number of litres purchased.
- Enter this amount in the Fuel Litres column for the period January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003 (see example \* below).

To calculate the litres for the interim refund period August 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002:

- i) Put all your receipts that fall between August 1, 2002 and December 31, 2002 in date order.
- ii) Add the litres from these receipts to obtain the number of litres purchased.

Enter this amount in the Fuel Litres column for the period August 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002 (see example \*\* below).
