



ESCAPE INCIDENT REPORT – Last Update: July 10, 2006

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Verbal reporting Requirements, pursuant to Section 4 of the Aquaculture Regulation:

“The holder, or a person acting on behalf of the holder, who discovers an escape or evidence suggesting an escape of finfish from an attachment structure or a containment structure in the holder’s aquaculture facility must report the escape or evidence to the manger (a) verbally within 24 hours of the discovery, and (b) in writing, within one week of the discovery.”

- To verbally report suspected finfish escapes, within 24 hours of discovery, contact the ministry’s toll-free escape incident reporting line at 1-877-223-4673.
