## Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is your authority to remove unmerchantable timber for personal use, to a maximum of six (6) cords (21.7 cubic metres) from Crown foreshore on Quadra Island or the East Coast of Vancouver Island within the Campbell River Forest District (see map on reverse), excluding private land, Indian reserves, ecological reserves, Federal, Provincial, Regional and Municipal parks and foreshore leases. This authorization terminates six months from date of issuance, and the product is to be delivered to above address by that date

The following conditions must be complied with:

- 1. This letter must be available on demand to authorized persons making inspections.
- 2. Only timber of a low statutory log grade of beach worn quality may be utilized. Logs bearing visible timber marks may not be cut or removed without the permission of timber mark holder.
- 3. Cedar, regardless of quality, is not to be removed from the foreshore.
- 4. Residual damage (such as sawdust or debris) resulting from the operation must be kept to a minimum and must not be allowed to accumulate below the mean high-water mark. Special care must be used to prevent oil or grease pollution at work site.
- 5. No right of access onto or through private lands, Indian reserves, ecological reserves, Federal, Provincial, Regional and Municipal parks and foreshore leases is given or implied by issuance of this letter. The onus is on the Permittee to determine the ownership of the foreshore. It is also the Permittee's responsibility to obtain the consent of any land owner or lease holder for access.
- 6. Definition of unmerchantable timber: logs under eight (8) feet (2.6 metres) in length that do not show a timber mark on either end of the log.
- 7. Do not cut firewood from foreshore areas adjacent to parks (e.g., Rebecca Spit, Goose Spit, Seal Bay, Miracle Beach, etc.).
- 8. Motorized vehicles are not to be used in the removal of timber from the foreshore.
