



## PERMIT TO HARVEST OYSTERS FROM VACANT CROWN FORESHORE

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, BC \_\_\_\_\_ has made application for a permit to harvest oysters from vacant Crown foreshore and has paid the fee of \$75.00 prescribed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council. Therefore the said \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby permitted, pursuant to Section 9 of the Fisheries Act Regulations, to harvest oysters from the vacant Crown foreshore herein described, and subject also to the permittee paying to the Province of British Columbia a royalty in the sum of \$25.00 per tonne (or portion thereof) for all oysters taken. Permittee and the original permit must be present when harvesting oysters from the following described Crown foreshore: \_\_\_\_\_, within DFO Statistical Area \_\_\_\_\_, subarea \_\_\_\_\_, as indicated on the map attached, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Any container holding shellfish must be tagged with the following: the name of the harvester, the DFO statistical area and sub-area, the date of harvest, and the permit number. Failure to comply may result in loss of product;
- 2) This permit does not grant permission to harvest from existing leases or from foreshore fronting First Nation Reserves;
- 3) This permit does not allow trespass on upland areas;
- 4) Permit holder is not to block access to upland areas;
- 5) All harvesters (**and helpers**) must have in their possession, a valid Fisher Registration Card;
- 6) A list of all helpers (if applicable) and their FRC numbers must be received in our office prior to the harvest date (address/fax number shown below);
- 7) The harvest log must be completed **IN INK AFTER EACH DAILY HARVEST, PRIOR TO THE HARVESTER LEAVING THE HARVEST AREA**; and,
- 8) **All product must be removed from the harvest area prior to the expiration of the permit.**
