Chilliwack Forest District Direct Issuance Small Scale Salvage Policy

- Maximum volume for a dead and down cedar salvage Forestry Licence to Cut (FLTC) is generally 500m3. Applications for volumes between 500m3 and 2000m3 should be discussed with the Small Scale Salvage Coordinator prior to an application
- Total area applied for as a dead and down cedar salvage FLTC must be under 400ha.
- Application area may have up to 2 units, but must be within the same geographic location (within 20 kms)
- Clients can only hold one FLTC at a time
- District Manager may not issue a sale if there is the potential for revenue loss.
- Clients who hold an active salvage sale can submit a new application after the licence documents are surrendered and the sale is finalized or in the last 60 days of the term of an existing licence.
 Applications submitted outside of these parameters will be returned to the applicant
- FLTC terms are for upto 2 years, with no extensions.
- Amendments will generally not be accepted.
- Applications are to be made via the professional application procedure.
- Applications for less than 50 m3 of decked (harvested) material and used engineering structures may be made outside of the professional application procedure.
- Approval and issuance of a Forestry Licence to Cut will be within 30 days in most cases if the Professional Application Procedures are followed.
- This policy may be amended from time to time as a result of legislative changes and operational needs.
