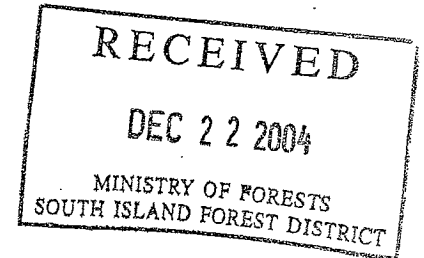

Notification is hereby given that pursuant to section 7(2) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* and section 9(3) of the *Woodlot Licence Planning and Practices Regulation*, the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection has produced Notices to indicate the amount of area, distribution of areas and attributes of those areas required for the survival of species at risk and the winter survival of specified ungulate species.

Forest agreement holders and woodlot licence holders will be notified of these Notices on or before December 30th, 2004.


