

<u>NOTICE – INDICATORS OF THE AMOUNT, DISTRIBUTION AND ATTRIBUTES OF</u> <u>WILDLIFE HABITAT REQUIRED FOR THE WINTER SURVIVAL OF UNGULATE</u> <u>SPECIES IN TREE FARM LICENSE 54</u>

This Notice is given under the authority of section 7(2) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 14/04).

The following Notice includes indicators of the amount, distribution and attributes of wildlife habitat required for the winter survival of the ungulate species outlined in Schedule 1.

This Notice applies as specified within Tree Farm License 54.

Schedule 1

Tree Farm License 54

Ungulate Species:

Black-tailed deer and Roosevelt elk

Amount:

An amount of area consistent with any direction provided in official and interim watersheds that are in effect within the Clayoquot Sound planning area.

Distribution:

Areas should be distributed consistent with any direction provided in official and interim watersheds that are in effect within the Clayoquot Sound planning area.

Attributes:

Attributes of areas should be consistent with any direction provided in official and interim watersheds that are in effect within the Clayoquot Sound planning area.
