
8.0 Access

8.1 Introduction:

“Access” was not perceived by the LRMP table as being a value in itself, but as having direct influence on the value of other resources. Whether access has a positive/negative connotation depends on the value under consideration and the viewpoint of the resource user. For perspective on this topic, focus is placed on the following indicators:

1. Access to facilitate natural resource management/extraction
2. Recreational access, focusing on backcountry or wilderness experiences
3. Access to candidate wilderness lakes
4. Circle routes
5. Access development in sensitive terrain
