HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code Amendment Act, 2006.

2 The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 2 amended

- 3 Section 2 is amended:
 - (a) in clause (1)(a) by striking out "but less than 65 years"; and
 - (b) by adding the following subsection after subsection (2):
 - "(3) Nothing in sections 9 to 19 prohibits a distinction on the basis of age if that distinction is permitted or required by any Act or regulation in force in Saskatchewan".

Section 10 amended

4 Subsection 10(2) is repealed.

Section 12 amended

- 5 Section 12 is amended:
 - (a) by repealing subsection (3); and
 - (b) in subsection (4) by adding "age," after "because of".

R.S.S. 1978, c.M-26 amended

- $\mathbf{6}(1)$ The Municipal Employees' Pension Act is amended in the manner set forth in this section.
- (2) The following section is added after section 3:

"Mandatory retirement prohibited

- **3.1** Notwithstanding anything in this Act, no employee shall be required to retire at a specific age".
- (3) Subsection 42(1) is amended by striking out ", with the consent of his employer,".

7 Subsection 20(3) of The Public Employees Pension Plan Act is repealed.

8 The following section is added after section 3 of *The Superannuation* (Supplementary Provisions) Act:

"Mandatory retirement prohibited

3.01 Notwithstanding anything in this Act or any superannuation Act, no employee shall be required to retire at a specific age".

9 Section 92 of The Public Service Regulations, 1999 is repealed.

10 This Act comes into force on the first anniversary of the date on which this Act receives assent.
