An Act to amend *The Limitations Act*

(Assented to)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Limitations Amendment Act, 2006*.

2 *The Limitations Act* is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 7 amended

3 **Subsection 7(3) is repealed.**

New section 7.1

4 **The following section is added after section 7:**

“Limitation period for judgments, orders

7.1 With respect to a claim based on a judgment or order for the payment of money, no proceeding shall be commenced after 10 years from the date of the judgment or order”.

Section 11 amended

5 **Subsection 11(2) is amended by striking out “or” after clause (a) and substituting “and”.**

Section 14 amended

6 **Subsection 14(1) is amended by striking out “notice of”.**

Section 15 amended

7 **Clause 15(b) is amended by striking out “subsection 7(3)” and substituting “section 7.1”.**

Section 21 amended

8 **Subsection 21(2) is amended by adding “the limitation period established by section 7.1 or” after “extend”.**

Coming into force

9 This Act comes into force on assent.
