## **APPLICATION FOR "CUSTOM FARM OPERATORS" TO OBTAIN A TEMPORARY FUEL TAX EXEMPTION PERMIT**

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

This application is for "custom farm operators" to obtain a Temporary Fuel Tax Exemption Permit.

The permit can be used only to purchase marked diesel fuel for use in unlicensed farm machinery while carrying out farm activities for a farmer as defined by the Farm Fuel Program.

Under the Farm Fuel Program, an eligible farmer is a person who owns or rents land, controls and is responsible for the operation of a farm and meets at least one of the following criteria:

The person must own or rent at least 75 acres (30 hectares) of cultivated land in Saskatchewan, that is used for the growing of cereal crops, and is the holder of a Canadian Wheat Board Permit; or

The person received gross annual revenue of at least \$10,000 from the sale of primary farm products that he or she produced in Saskatchewan.

A person may also qualify as a farmer if he or she is a member or shareholder in a farm organization, such as an agricultural corporation, farm partnership, a farm co-operative, or a farm colony, and contributed substantially to the agricultural production of that farm organization.

The permit is valid only while doing custom work for eligible farmers and must be renewed on an annual basis.
