RE: APPLICABLE ACTS AND REGULATIONS FOR OIL AND GAS EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN SASKATCHEWAN

This bulletin is intended to provide a summary of some of the applicable acts and regulations relating to petroleum and natural gas drilling and seismic exploration in Saskatchewan, and to identify the responsible provincial regulator. This bulletin is not a complete summary of acts and regulations applicable to oil and gas developments in Saskatchewan, and is not a substitute for the full text of the listed acts and regulations. It is the proponent's responsibility to ensure that all requirements have been met before initiating any project.

This bulletin was prepared by Saskatchewan Economic and Co-operative Development in cooperation with the four main provincial agencies involved with regulating oil and gas exploration and development. Those regulators are: Municipal Affairs and Housing; Saskatchewan Energy and Mines (SEM); Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management (SERM); and Saskatchewan Agriculture and Food (SAF).

The regulations provide rules and regulations that will provide safety to the public from seismic operations.
	The Oil and Gas Conservation Act (Ref.# O-2) - The Oil and Gas Conservation Regulations, 1985 (Ref.# Reg 1)	Applies to the conservation of oil and gas resources. The regulations pertain to well licensing; the Oil and Gas Environmental Fund; prohibited drilling areas; approval of drilling; and completion of operations.
