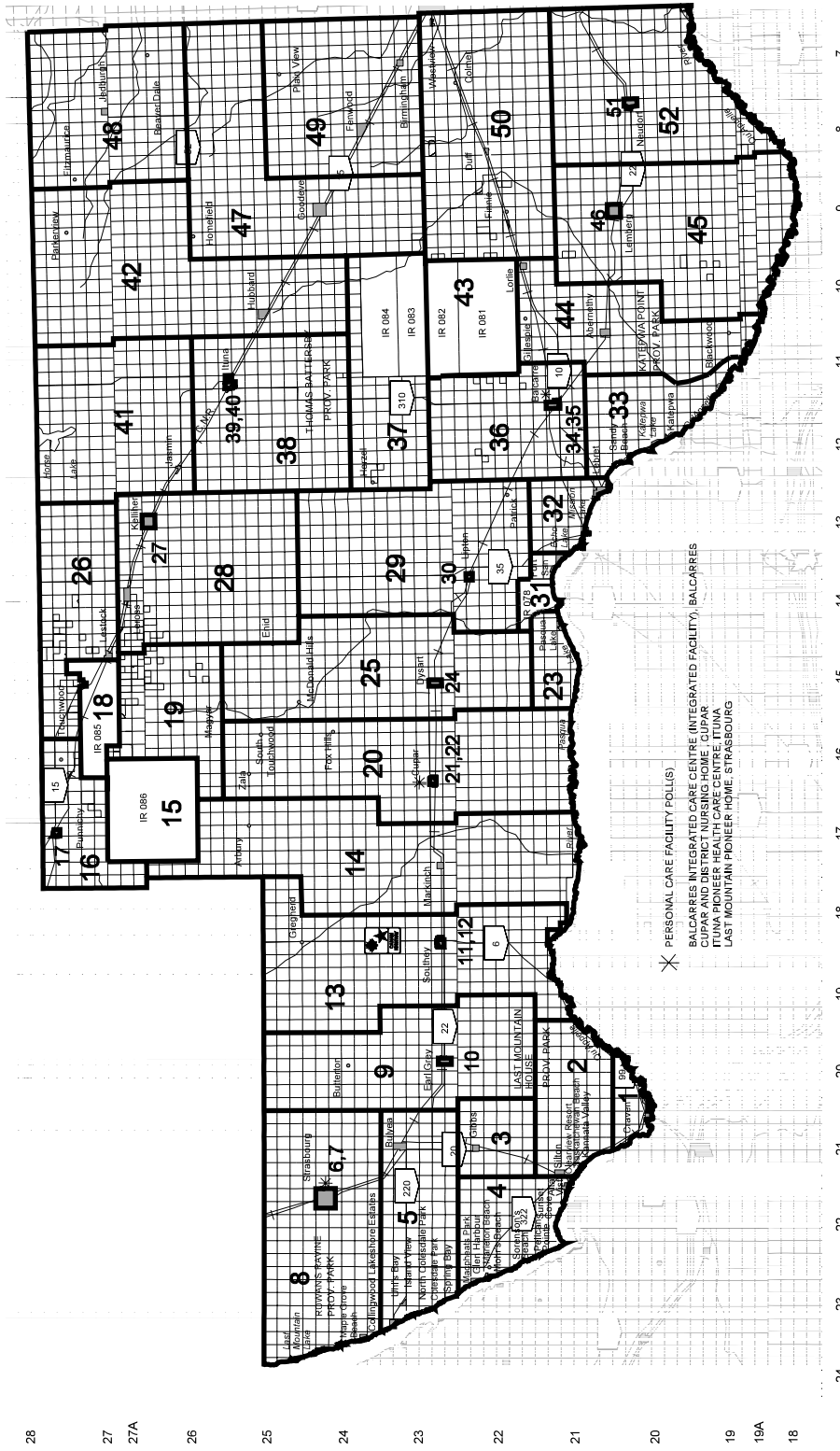

TOWNSHIPS

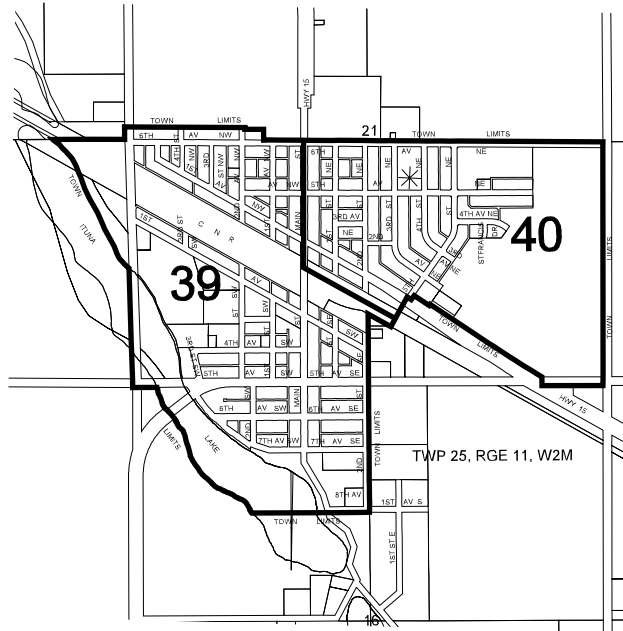
