### IS THE YOUTH OPPORTUNITIES UNLEASHED (YOU) PROGRAM FOR YOU?

Are you:

- $\square$  18 30 years old, and
- ☑ interested in starting or expanding your own business?

YOU helps young entrepreneurs realize their business ambitions. How? With financing and training.

#### **FINANCING**

Loans of up to \$15,000 are available to help you start or expand a business. YOU entrepreneurs can use loans from their local Small Business Loans Association (SBLA) to purchase assets such as equipment and tools. (The monies cannot be used for operating expenses or to repay existing debt.) Loans are granted at competitive interest rates, for a maximum term of five years.

#### To qualify you must:

- Have a complete, feasible business plan (including a three-year financial projection);
- Provide information on your intentions for training and mentoring; and
- Submit a loan application (including a demand promissory note, a general security agreement and a \$60 non-refundable application fee) to your local SBLA. Applicants may be required to pledge additional security, provide a co-signer or a guarantor.
