 This is the first step in registering your business.
- Choose a Domain Name (optional)
 To register your business web address (e.g. www.bcbusinessregistry.ca)
- 4 Register a Proprietorship or Partnership

Incorporate Your Company

Register a <u>Proprietorship or Partnership</u> (also known as "doing business as", or DBA) Or <u>Incorporate Your Company</u> and file other Business Corporations Act forms over the Internet.

5 Register with other Public Agencies

Go here for GST, Payroll Deductions, WorkSafeBC - the Workers' Compensation Board of B.C., PST, Hotel Room Tax and Municipal Business Licences (plus more).

6 Change Your Business Address

Automatically notify many participating public agencies (a BCeID is required).


