Re: Fee Increases for Certificate Registration and Examinations

The Boiler and Pressure Vessel Fees Amendment Regulations, 2002 were filed on December 19, 2002 and gazetted on January 10, 2003.

The new schedule of fees related to the five (5) year registration of certificates will come into force effective **January 15, 2003**.
