## Statement of Continuance Form 28 INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION

- **Format:** Documents required to be sent to the Director pursuant to the Act must conform with sections 4 to 6 of the regulations under the Act.
- **Item 1:** Set out the full legal name of the corporation.
- **Item 2:** Give the date and jurisdiction of incorporation or date and jurisdiction of amalgamation and of interjurisdictional transfer, if any, and change of name.

Examples of information required:

- (a) ABC Holdings Ltd. was incorporated under the laws of Alberta on January 15, 1921 as XYZ Agencies Ltd. - changed to its present name on April 15, 1930 - continued as a Manitoba corporation under its present name on January 10, 1977.
- (b) A.B.C. Holdings Ltd. resulted from the amalgamation of A.B.C. Enterprises Ltd. and A.B.C. Investments Ltd. under the laws of Alberta on February 14, 1965, etc.
- Item 3: State the main actual business or businesses of the corporation.
- **Item 4:** For use only if additional information is provided.
