

INFORMATION SHEET FOR APPLICANTS CLINICAL PLACEMENT BURSARIES SASKATCHEWAN HEALTH BURSARY PROGRAM

BURSARY PROGRAM

The purpose of Saskatchewan Health's Bursary program is to recruit and retain needed health care professionals to meet the needs of the people of Saskatchewan. The Saskatchewan Health Clinical Placement Bursary is offered to students in an eligible program that requires the completion of a clinical placement as part of training.

ELIGIBILITY

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THIS SASKATCHEWAN HEALTH BURSARY, YOU MUST:

- 1. Be a Saskatchewan resident with a valid Health Card.
- 2. Be accepted into approved clinical placement training before graduation.
- 3. Applicants who have a return for service agreement with the Province of Saskatchewan are eligible to apply.
- 4. Applicants must **not be** in a salaried position during their clinical placement.

BURSARY AMOUNT RETURN SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Clinical Placements: \$3,000.00 - \$8,000.00 one time payment.

Bursaries are awarded to individuals who sign a contract agreeing to, upon graduation, provide a specific period of service in an approved publicly funded position in Saskatchewan.

For bursary assistance, bursary recipients are required to provide the following period of service:

- 2 years in the cities of Regina or Saskatoon.
 - OR
- 1 year in all other areas of the Province.

Failure to provide the return service means bursary funds must be repaid, including interest, at the rate stipulated in the bursary agreement

APPLICATION PROCESS

The following documentation should be submitted to Saskatchewan Health (address below):

- ü A completed application form.
- ü A letter from a Regional Health Authority, or any other approved employer that provides publicly funded health services, acknowledging applicant's acceptance into a clinical placement program and indicating the length of the program.
- ü A resume including work experience.

No Application Deadline

SELECTION PROCESS

Bursaries are awarded through a competitive selection process. Not all applicants are awarded a bursary.
