PURCHASE OF UNALLOCATED ANTLERLESS MULE DEER LICENCES

Updated November 6, 2006

Please read the following before you purchase a First or Second Antlerless Mule Deer Licence.

Starting September 1, 2006, First or Second Antlerless Mule Deer licences became available at the following Saskatchewan Environment offices. These licences can be purchased in **person only** on a first-come, first-served basis at the following Saskatchewan Environment offices:

- First or Second Antlerless Mule Deer licences for all Wildlife Management Zones (WMZs) will continue to be available in Regina by contacting Saskatchewan Environment at (306) 787-2886. They are available on a first-come, first-served basis. The telephone line is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to Noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. There is only one telephone line so if the line is busy please keep trying. Licences will be mailed every Friday. If you wish to have your licence delivered by courier, etc. arrangements can be made, but at your cost.
- Only Saskatchewan residents may purchase a First or Second Antlerless Mule Deer licence.
- An antlerless mule deer is a doe or a 2006 fawn.

- If you do NOT already hold a First Antlerless Mule Deer Licence you may purchase either a First Antlerless Mule Deer Licence or both First and Second Antlerless Mule Deer Licences at the same time.
- If you already hold a First Antlerless Mule Deer Licence you may purchase a Second Antlerless Mule Deer Licence.
- **Some** First and Second Antlerless Mule Deer Licences have a **two deer bag limit**, depending on the Zone (see table below).
- Licences are valid for the season dates listed in the 2006 Saskatchewan Hunters' and Trappers' Guide.
- The cost of each licence is \$19.81. You may purchase licences for up to four applicants at one time. Payment may be made by cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Cheques or money orders should be made payable to **Saskatchewan Environment**.

- A 2006 Wildlife Habitat Certificate, which costs \$10.90, is required to validate any big game licence. Wildlife Habitat Certificates can be purchased at any Saskatchewan Environment office or hunting licence vendor. Do not call the phone number previously mentioned to order Wildlife Habitat Certificates.
- The person purchasing the licence or licences must verify that: 1) all applicants authorize Saskatchewan Environment to confirm their status as Saskatchewan residents by using the Saskatchewan Health Insurance Registration file; 2) all applicants comply with Firearm Safety Regulations; and 3) none of the applicants are applying for a hunting licence while under suspension, pursuant to The-Wildlife Act, 1988 and Regulations.
