# Administration of Small and Rural Schools

## **University of Saskatchewan**

The Administration of Small and Rural Schools program provides an online version of a graduate university-credit course in educational administration. The course uses software for designing and offering interactive materials over the World Wide Web. All course material, including notes, additional readings, resources, assignments and quizzes, is available at the web site. Students communicate privately with each other and the instructor and participate in class discussion using FirstClass Collaborative Classroom.

Interaction between the students and instructor, and discussion among students are an important part of any graduate-level course. The course web site facilitates such communication.

The demand for the graduate program in educational administration at the University of Saskatchewan is growing. This course improves access anywhere for students who cannot attend regular on-campus courses.
