REVOCATION ORDER

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") issued a temporary order on the 19th day of December, 1989 and an extending order (the "Extending Order") on the 3rd day of January 1990 pursuant to subsection 134(3) of The Securities Act, 1988, S.S. 1988, c.S-42.2 (the "Act") that trading in securities of Vertical Software Corporation (the "Issuer") shall cease;

AND WHEREAS an application has been received by the Commission from the staff of the Commission to have the Extending Order revoked;

AND WHEREAS the staff has represented to the Commission that the Issuer has now filed, in an acceptable form, financial statements for the three month period ending June 30, 1989 and the six month period ending September 30, 1989, as required under section 86(1)(b) of the Act and sections 122 and 123 of The Securities Regulations, R.R.S., c. S-42.2 Reg 1 (the "Regulations");

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest to make this order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to section 158(3) of the Act, that the Extending Order dated the 3rd day of January 1990 be and is hereby revoked as against Vertical Software Corporation effective the date of this order.
