RULING
(Section 83)

WHEREAS an application has been received by the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") from Westrange Corp. ("Westrange") for a ruling pursuant to clause 83(1)(a) of *The Securities Act, 1988, SS 1988, c. S-42.2* (the "Act") that Westrange be deemed to be a reporting issuer within the meaning of the Act for any and all purposes of the Act and the regulations thereto;

AND WHEREAS it was represented by Westrange to the Commission that:

1. Westrange is a corporation incorporated pursuant to the laws of Alberta on November 29, 1996 and is in good standing with the Alberta Registrar of Corporations;
2. The authorized capital of Westrange consists of an unlimited number of common shares (the "Common shares") and unlimited number of preferred shares issuable in series (the "Preferred Shares") of which there are currently issued and outstanding 6,108,581 Common Shares and no Preferred Shares;
3. The Common Shares are listed and posted for trading on the Canadian Venture Exchange Inc. and trade under the symbol "WRC";
4. Westrange is a reporting issuer pursuant to the laws of Alberta and has been a reporting issuer in Alberta since February 24, 1997 by virtue of filing and obtaining a receipt for a prospectus;
5. Westrange is not included on the list of defaulting reporting issuers maintained by the Alberta Securities Commission; and

6. Westrange wishes to become a reporting issuer within the meaning of the Act in order to avoid an indefinite hold period on its securities that may be traded under statutory prospectus exemptions contained in the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest to grant the Ruling;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Act that Westrange be deemed to be a reporting issuer within the meaning of the Act for any and all purposes of the Act and the regulations thereto effective as of the date of this Ruling.
